



Understanding Demographic Data

Understanding Demographic Data is a one day seminar which aims to help participants better understand demographic trends and better utilise demographic data. The seminar provides awareness of demographic data produced by the ABS and gives an introduction to demographic techniques to enable comparisons of demographic data between regions and over time.

Key issues to be covered during the seminar include:

- Relationship of Population Census counts to Estimated Resident Population data
- Components of population change: births; deaths; and migration
- Changing demographic trends
- How the ABS produces projections and population estimates
- Tools for demographic analysis, with practical exercises
- Population dynamics, e.g. ageing, and migration, and their effect on Australia's population profile

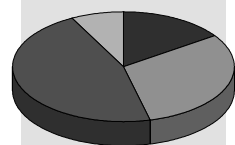

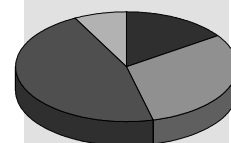
